1. Ensure the financial health of the college (Institutional Goal # 8)
 - ❖ Develop alternative sources of income

 - ❖ Analyze current strategies and develop new assessment tools for student retention and completion

4. Encourage and support professional development (Institutional Goal #4)
 - ❖ Support the assessment and analysis of professional development needs through the existing committee structure (CDAC, Faculty Development, and Exempt Development)
 - ❖ Facilitate participation in activities for all employees
 - ❖ Invest in professional development that relates to the college-wide priorities and institutional goals
